Dear Friends,

"And the Word became Flesh and dwelt among us. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the only begotten Son of the Father, full of grace and truth. In him was life, and that life was the light of all people.

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not understood It" John Chapter One (excerpted)

The majestic words of The Gospel of John. This writer's testimony to the entry of God into our world on the first Christmas.

How can they bless us, this year?

One of my favorite past-times is to ponder great works of art. The birth of Jesus has been the subject for countless works of art, with each artist attempting to somehow capture the essence of this momentous and mysterious event. The above example, by the Italian baroque artist Federico Barocci, employs a technique used by many of his contemporaries--namely the use of the infant Jesus as the light source for the painting. Notice how the light upon Mary—the light that catches the robes of Joseph—and the light that illuminates the faces of the shepherds—all come from a single light source: The face of Jesus.

I have always found this technique deeply theological. With Jesus being present, we are able to see our surroundings clearly--His light guides and protects us. Without His light we are able to see little, or nothing at all—we are likely to stumble in the darkness. What, then, is the "glory of God"—to return to the words of John's gospel? As I see it, the "glory of God" is seen the fact that God entered long ago into our world on a mission to light up every aspect of our lives. To me, the birth of Jesus shows God's desire to provide the clarity we need in this life. You could say that Barocci's painting is filled with the glory of God.

We continue to live in dark and confusing times—and in times that have exhausted us in many ways. My prayer for all of us, this Christmas 2021, is that we will be like Mary, Joseph—indeed, all the characters we see in this painting: That we will choose to draw nearer to Jesus and to allow His light to fill our lives more fully. May each of us experience—even more deeply—the comfort—and joy—that God intends for our lives as we do so!
