Will you join them?




## Mask Policy

## Beaver Area School District Opportunity

Beaver Area Middle School (Grades 7-8) in the Beaver Area School District is looking to fill one of our currently vacant Teaching Assistant (TA) positions. Through this position, this individual would work closely with our special education staff as well as our content area faculty to ensure that students' needs are being met daily. With the role of the teaching assistant, there is also a great deal of work that is done with individual students who may need academic support. This may include pushing into content area classes to support and redirect students, provide small group testing for learners, and assist with organization, among other duties. Applicants must be able to provide their PA Criminal History, PA Child Abuse, and FBI Fingerprint clearances and must hold at least an associate degree equivalency. The hours for this position are 7:20 a.m. - 2:55 p.m. daily, and the hourly rate is \$11.00/hr. ## **Presbytery Meeting Summary - September 28, 2021**

The Beaver-Butler Presbytery held its stated meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 28, 2021, using a Hybrid format, in-person and via Zoom. The meeting was hosted by Covenant Church, Butler, where John Silbert serves as pastor. *This was the first time presbyters were able to be face-to-face in 18 months!* Moderator Elder Judy Lipscak presided over the meeting.

### **STATED CLERK REPORT:**

- Clerk Byers referred the presbyters to two additional reports regarding the installations of the Rev. Todd Allen, Park Church, Beaver, and the Rev. Brian Hauser, Mars Church, Mars.
- Clerk Byers announced to the Presbytery that after 28 years in the Office of the Clerk, he will be retiring as Stated Clerk of the Presbytery, effective December 31, 2021. The Clerk emphasized the honor and privilege it was for him to serve.

### **EXECUTIVE PRESBYTER REPORT:**

Rev. Dr. Harmon reflected upon his past seven months service as Executive, including churches and sessions visited.

### **MINISTRY & VOCATION COMMITTEE:**

The Ministry & Vocation Committee moved, and the presbytery approved, an increase of 3.5% in the 2022 Minimum Terms of Call for Ministers of Word and Sacrament and Certified Christian Educators.

### **PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:**

The Personnel Committee moved, and the presbytery approved, a 3.5% COLA for 2022 for the Presbytery Staff.

### **ACTIONS TAKEN:**

- Approved the 2022 Per Capita amount at \$31.52 per member.
- At the Church Session's request, the Presbytery will match \$.50 per dollar, up to the Church's assessed and remitted Synod and/or GA Per Capita. The deadline for this match will be December 1, 2022.
- Approved the 2022 Budget.
